

STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY

At the end of the session a student satisfaction survey was conducted physically in which about 120 students from undergraduate and 30 from post graduate classes participated. The questionnaire covered almost all the aspects related to the quality and atmosphere of teaching learning, infrastructure, extra-curricular activities, extension activities mentee-mentor practice, campus environment and basic amenities, behavior of teachers, non-teaching staff and fellow students and the facilities for competitive exams preparations and placement etc.

After collection, the students' responses were examined and studied by the feedback committee of teachers which presented its summarized report to IQAC. It was a matter of great satisfaction that-most of the students liked the overall academic environment in the campus and rated it as excellent or fairly good. In all, about 75% of the questions were responded favourably. About 90% of the students were satisfied with their teachers, teaching-practices, pre-university exams, extracurricular activities, N.S.S., Rangers, and the newly opened N.C.C. units, mentor-mentee practice etc. and agreed that their mentors are truly working as their friend, philosopher & guide individually and helping them to overcome their fears and difficulties faced in the campus.

However, some students complained about the cleaners and hygiene and the non-availability of vehicle-stand. As a matter of suggestion, the students demanded the provision coaching of NET/SLET in the campus starting the post-graduate programmes in Music and Drawing & Painting.

The IQAC and the College administration took a serious note of students' complaints and suggestions and is working to resolve these issues and other petty grievances of students.
